# FOUNDING STORY

The inspiration for the United Religions Initiative came in 1993 when The Right Rev. William E. Swing planned to host an interfaith service for the United Nations' 50th anniversary. After being unable to meaningfully engage religious leaders, he invited community members from around the world—from all faiths, backgrounds, and traditions—to co-create a grassroots initiative for peace. In 2000, the Charter was signed and URI was born.

These core values of URI—our Preamble, Purpose, and Principles—are listed in the enclosed poster. 




